Fundraising Requirement

Horizons for Homeless Children receives bib numbers for the Boston Marathon through the John Hancock Non-Profit Marathon Program. As a member of the John Hancock Non-Profit Marathon Program, there are fundraising guidelines that we must follow. **All members of the 2024 Team Horizons must raise a minimum of \$8,500.** We hope all runners will strive to surpass this minimum by setting goals above the required \$8,500. Please note that your projected goal, as stated below, considered during the selection process. All funds support Horizons for Homeless Children's mission to provide children experiencing homelessness with opportunities to learn, play, and thrive.

Please be aware that if a runner is unable to reach the \$8,500 minimum for any reason, Horizons for Homeless Children is required to charge the remaining balance on that runner's credit card.
