Good morning – *Buenos días*

Good evening – *Buenas noches*

Nice to meet you. – *Mucho gusto*

Thank you – *Gracias*

You're welcome – *De nada*

See you later – *Hasta luego*

Goodbye – *Adiós / Chau*

Excuse me – *Perdón*

Friends – *Amigos*

A little bit – *Un poquito*

Not much – *No mucho*

More or less – *Más o menos*

I enjoy having him/her here. – *Me encanta tenerla/lo aquí.*
