The Playspace program is looking for volunteers to play with children experiencing homelessness for just two hours each week!

Horizons Playspace program provides young children in homeless shelters a safe and dedicated space to play, learn, and have fun! Playspaces include toys, books, and activities to engage creativity, imagination, physical and social development. Playspaces are staffed with trained, caring, volunteers, called PALs (Playspace Activity Leaders), who commit to volunteering at the same time and same shelter location for two hours each week. Volunteers must be at least 16 years old and must volunteer with an adult or guardian until age 18. School groups can have one designated adult.
